



COMMUNITY CAMPUS CODE OF CONDUCT

The Community Campus is committed to providing a SAFE & WELCOMING environment for all members and guests. To promote safety and comfort for all, we ask all individuals to act appropriately at all times when in our facility or participating in our programs.

The actions listed below, which are not intended to be an all-inclusive list of behaviors, are considered INAPPROPRIATE & PROHIBITED when using the Community Campus facility or participating in Community Campus programming.

- ⇒ Using or possessing alcohol or illegal drugs
- ⇒ Smoking, including e-cigarettes—the Community Campus is a smoke-free environment
- ⇒ Carrying or concealing a weapon or any device or object that may be used as a weapon
- ⇒ Harassment or intimidation by words, gestures or body language
- ⇒ Physical contact with another person in an angry, aggressive or threatening way
- ⇒ Verbally abusive behavior, including profanity, angry language, name calling or shouting
- ⇒ Sexually explicit conversation or behavior and any sexual contact with another person
- ⇒ Inappropriate, immodest or sexually revealing attire
- ⇒ Theft or behavior that results in the destruction or loss of property
- ⇒ Loitering within the facilities or on the grounds of the Community Campus
- ⇒ Use of any camera, including a cell phone camera, in a Community Campus locker room
- ⇒ Taking pictures of any person without their consent and knowledge

Suspension or Termination of Community Campus membership may result from a violation of this Code of Conduct. While an incident is being investigated, the membership of the accused person may be temporarily suspended pending a final decision.
