- Expanded meal opportunities, lunch spaces, and cooking classes
- New, secure outdoor Courtyard space for socialization, events, with gardening programs, barbecues and other outdoor-indoor program offerings
- Social lounge space for informal conversations, small group activities, and camaraderie
