Bright Beginnings Preschool

The Bright Beginnings Preschool is divided by age groups. The Preschool runs 5 days per week and includes 9 different classes in the morning and afternoon. Each age 2 ½ to 4 are in separate classes. Each age group has a unique curriculum including social, academic, arts and physical components. We also provide enrichment programs which run every afternoon that children can attend to enhance their learning experiences. This program runs from 12:00 pm to 3:00 pm every day and includes swim lessons, cooking, literacy as well as a STEM component.

The expansion of the JCC Early Childhood Education wing and the creation of the Marion and Norman Tanzman Center for *LifeLong Living* will provide:

- Expansion of class space for the 2½ year old and the 4 year old classes
- New and renovated classroom spaces
- Enhanced security for the Early Childhood education wing
- New bathrooms for the children
- A new resource room for teacher preparation and conferences
- Media management room for printer, laminator, and diecut machine and materials
- Space for snacks
- Increased and logistically improved storage for supplies
